THE BIG LISTEN

You will have seen in the news over the past few months (since the tragic death of Headteacher Ruth Perry) that Ofsted have realised their system of inspection needs a radical overhaul!

As part of this Ofsted are running a Big Listen up until 31st May and they would like as many parents as possible to take part in the survey. You can access it here.

Everyone agrees that schools need to be accountable and we are well aware that some parents still use an Ofsted grading as a reason for choosing a school but the system is flawed and needs reform (even the new Chief Inspector, Martyn Oliver, recognises this).

As a Headteacher, areas where I think it could be improved are:

- Getting rid of single word judgements e.g. inadequate, good, outstanding these are not very helpful i.e. you can have a 'good' school who has just scraped that judgement or a 'good' school which is brilliant but you wouldn't know this from the Ofsted judgement
- Becoming more developmental i.e. Ofsted come in, make a judgement after one or two days then leave without any suggestions of <u>how</u> you could improve the areas they have identified
 - Provide a more accurate 'Ofsted window' at the moment schools are in a 'window' for
 inspection which can last two or three years (here at Woodstone we have been in it for two
 years already and it could extend to September 2025). This is unfair and puts unnecessary
 stress on school staff. A window of three months would be more appropriate i.e. you know
 they are coming within that three months but you don't know exactly when.

If you have got ten minutes to complete the survey/type your own thoughts into the text box we would greatly appreciate it as it could possibly influence and improve the process in the future. Thank you.
