On Friday 10th February we had a very special visitor in school working with our Year 3, 4 and 5 class. Mr Egypt came to Woodstone and shared his wonderful, hands on experience of Ancient Egypt with the three classes. It was an absolutely fantastic day which had all the children (and teachers) on the edge of their seats listening to his wonderful stories and engaging in his well thought out workshops. The fact that he had been

involved in so many excavations in Egypt and brought real artefacts with him that he'd been involved with discovering meant so much to the children. For days afterwards they did not stop talking about the day - Mr Egypt really did make quite an impression!

The picture above is of an actual spoon and oil bottle - Mr Egypt explained that when the mummification process is complete, the priest feeds the special oil to the pharaoh as his final meal on earth.

Mr Egypt actually found this on one of his excavations and told the children that it was used on a real pharaoh! Quite a cool discovery!
